  - 1. Trustee Ross stated there is no update on the water tower.
  - 2. Trustee Ross stated that they had a committee meeting on the water rate increase of 25% we received from Bond/Madison and our water rate increase. Trustee Richeson made a motion to approve the rate increases Trustee Ross's committee suggested as follows: In Town- first 2,000 gallons \$20.79 minimum charge

Over 2,000 gallons \$10.80 per 1,000 gallons

Out of Town- first 2,000 gallons \$40.20 minimum charge

Over 2,000 gallons \$16.07 per gallon

Bulk rate will increase to \$1.00 per 40 gallons.

To take effect for June's billing. Trustee Ross seconds. Roll call vote, all in favor, motion passed.

- 3. Altitude valve for water tower was tabled.
- 4. Trustee Schmidt made a motion to approve the increase for the materials from Litteken Plumbing for the dry hydrant for the amount of \$6,120. Trustee Gavlick seconds. Roll call vote, all in favor, motion passed.

5. Trustee Gavlick made a motion to approve the Sanitary Sewer Lining Engineering agreement in the amount not exceed \$4,200. Trustee Richeson seconds. Roll call vote, all in favor, motion passed.
