## **ORDINANCE 24-628**

## AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE ILLINOIS PAID LEAVE FOR ALL WORKERS ACT FOR THE VILLAGE OF ST. JACOB

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/8-1-1 et seq., provides that the corporate authorities may appropriate money for corporate purposes only and provide for payment of debts and expenses of the corporation.; and

WHEREAS, the Village of St. Jacob operates according to the Illinois Municipal Code as a Village, with such authority, employing employees and engineers to accomplish is statutory purpose; and

WHEREAS, on or about March 12, 2023, Governor JB Pritzker signed into law the Paid Leave for All Workers Act (820 ILCS 192/1 et seg.) (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois did not make the necessary appropriations or include statutory language exempting the Act from the Illinois State Mandates Act (30 ILCS 805/1 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2024, the Act requires an employer to provide certain paid leave to their employees, unless the employer is subject to an existing ordinance that requires the employer to provide any form of paid leave to their employees; and

WHEREAS, the Village of St. Jacob recognizes the importance of paid leave and currently provides reasonable paid leave benefits to its employees through existing leave policies and applicable collective bargaining agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Village of St. Jacob has determined that applying the Act to its own employees will negatively impact the Village of St. Jacob, placing an undue financial and operational burden on the Village of St. Jacob's ability to provide uninterrupted services to its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village of St. Jacob believes and hereby declares that it is in the best interests of the Village of St. Jacob to clearly define the paid leave benefits that Village of St. Jacob employees shall receive.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. JACOB, IN A MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED:

**Section 1**. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated as findings of fact as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 15(p) of the Act, the Village of St. Jacob hereby adopts its current paid leave policies and procedures for all Village of St. Jacob employees as set forth in the Village of St. Jacob's Code of Ordinances, any and all employee handbooks, annual salary ordinances if any, and any/or all collective bargaining agreements to which the Village of St. Jacob may be a party, and all other binding legislative actions governing paid

leave adopted by the Board of Trustees, as the same may be amended from time to time. However, in no event shall the Village of St. Jacob provide less than one (1) day of paid leave per year to any Village of St. Jacob employee.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. All ordinances, resolutions, and policies or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of the conflict, expressly repealed on the effective date of this Ordinance.

**Section 4**. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this Ordinance is severable.

**Section 5**. The Village Clerk of the Village of St. Jacob is directed by the Board of Trustees to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication.
